INTERNSHIP SUMMARY:

The Sustainable Development Institute (SDI) at the College of Menominee Nation (CMN) – Keshena Campus seeks a paid student intern for the summer 2017. The intern will assist with ongoing research activities on climate change and Tribes in the [Northeast Climate Science Center's \(NECSC\) region](#) which covers 81 Tribes and 22 states from Maine to Minnesota. The intern will directly be involved in the effort to create a digital media story about the Indigenous Planning Summer Institute, which will take place June 5-9, 2017. Other activities will include working with SDI on its website for climate change related activities.

INTERNSHIP DESCRIPTION:

- Participate in the Indigenous Planning Summer Institute hosted by SDI at the Whispering Pines Retreat Camp, Shawano Lake, Wisconsin, June 5-9, 2017.
- Assist with the filming, editing, and completion of digital media products related to our climate change and Tribes projects, including the Indigenous Planning Summer Institute.
- Assist SDI with projects related to Northeast Climate Science Center (NECSC) sponsored projects.
- Explore sustainable development issues in the face of climate change risks.
- Work within a team environment and independently to carry out assigned tasks.
- Develop and present overview of internship experience to CMN and broader communities.
- Perform other job-related duties as assigned.

Program Requirements/Qualifications:

- Must be at least a three-quarter time (9-11 credits) degree seeking student enrolled at the College of Menominee Nation or other accredited College or University.
- Must have completed at least one semester of her/his studies.
- Pursuing a degree in a field that relates to the responsibilities of this position such as, digital media, or a related degree.
- Must have an accumulative GPA of 2.75 or better on a 4.0 scale.
- Ability to communicate effectively in person, on the phone, and in writing for a variety of audiences.
- Attention to detail and strong work ethic.
- Must be willing to travel to area communities and/or remote locations within the Menominee Forest.
- Background check required.
